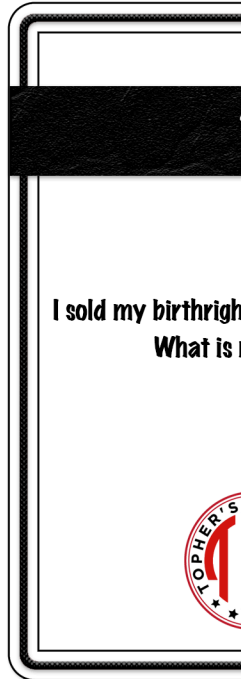

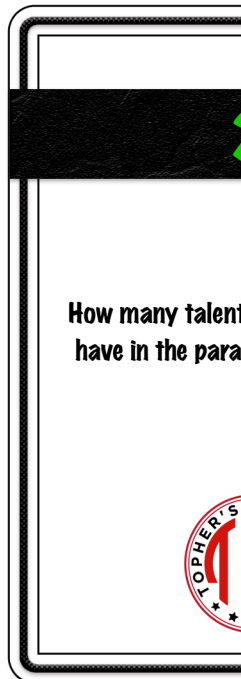
Once again, thank you for your love, prayers and support. We are in this together! And don't forget to tag me when you're playing this amazingly fun game! Until next time, stay in that Word!

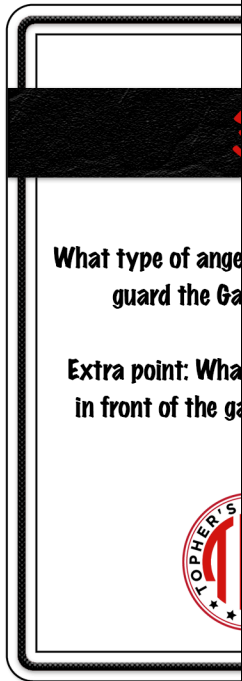
Complexity/Difficulty Level/Point System



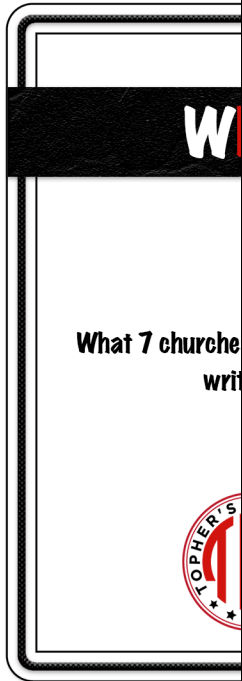
Cards that have the number 1 on them (in the black strip at the top) are easy to answer questions. Additionally, they are worth one point. Lastly, if you don't answer the question correctly or if you don't answer it at all, you would lose one point.



Cards that have the number 2 on them (in the black strip at the top) are standard questions. These questions are worth two points. Lastly, if you don't answer the question correctly or if you don't answer it at all, you would lose two points.



Cards that have the number 3 on them (in the black strip at the top) are questions that are more challenging than the rest. These questions are worth three points. Lastly, if you don't answer the question correctly or if you don't answer it at all, you would lose three points.



Wild cards allow you to earn points in accordance with your correct answers. For example, on the Wild card (featured left), you have the ability to earn seven points; that is if you are able to correctly list the seven churches that Apostle Paul wrote to. Additionally, for every wrong answer, you will lose a point. If you are unable to provide an answer or a correct answer, you would lose five points. If you can answer, at minimum, one correctly, you will earn a single point, and you will not lose any additional points.

Note: Some Wild cards require that you give a certain amount of correct answers. Follow the rules on those particular cards.
